Guidance for All Members

- Be respectful and polite in all online communications.
- Only post or share content that shows volleyball and the club in a positive way.
- Protect your personal information and don't share personal details such as address, phone numbers etc.
- Report any messages or online behaviour that makes you feel uncomfortable.
- Don't post negative, hurtful or abusive comments about players, coaches, officials or the club.
- Don't use social media to bully, harass or embarrass others.

Guidance for Young Members

- Set your privacy settings to "Friends Only" or "Private."
- Only connect with people you know in real life.
- Tell your parent, carer or coach if you see something online that worries you.
- Don't share personal details such as information about your school
- Dont' share or repost inappropriate images, videos or language.
- Don't accept friend requests from unknown users or adults.

Guidance for Coaches, Volunteers & Adults in Positions of Trust

- Communicate with young people only for volleyball related matters.
- Use group messages and include parents/carers whenever possible.
- Keep all interactions transparent and professional.
- Don't send private messages to young players.
- Don't accept or send friend/follow requests to young people on personal social media accounts.
